House Bill No. 2082

HOUSE BILL NO. 2082 - By: WESSELHOFT, MURPHEY AND FAUGHT of the House.

An Act relating to state government; requiring certain entities to make travel expenses public; requiring benefit be stated for each travel expense; providing for records to be posted on website; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 500.38 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 The Oklahoma Department of Education and the Oklahoma Commission for
5 Teacher Preparation shall make public all travel expenses and state the direct benefit to
6 the education system for each listed travel expense. The travel expense records shall be
7 open for public inspection during regular business hours and posted on the Department
8 of Education’s website.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
