House Bill No. 2087

HOUSE BILL NO. 2087 - By: JOYNER AND SCHWARTZ of the House.

An Act relating to cities and towns; authorizing a national criminal history records check prior to the appointment of certain persons; specifying payment; requiring submission of fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 29-103.1 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Prior to appointing a paid member of a municipal fire department, each
5 department may conduct a national criminal history records check, as defined by Section
6 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 B. Each applicant, upon request, shall furnish the department with two completed
8 fingerprint cards and a money order or a cashier's check made payable to the Oklahoma
9 State Bureau of Investigation for the fee for a national fingerprint criminal history
10 records check. The Bureau shall retain one set of fingerprints in the Automated
11 Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) and submit the other set to the Federal Bureau
12 of Investigation (FBI) for a national criminal history records check.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
