COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2332 - By: MURPHEY of the House.

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 90.2, which relates to the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; modifying procedures related to expenditures for postal services; amending Section 1, Chapter 340, O.S.L. 2008, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 451, O.S.L. 2009 (62 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 41.5a-4), which relates to the Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance; clarifying type of electronic storage for removal; specifying type of electronic storage media eligible for certain funds; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 90.2, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 Section 90.2 ~~No money shall be expended~~ Expenditures by any agency, board,
4 commission, department or institution of the state for postage stamps or post office box
5 rent ~~except on vouchers~~ shall only be made payable to United States Post Office ~~and the~~
6 ~~warrant or check shall be endorsed by the postmaster from where the purchase is made.~~

7 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 340, O.S.L. 2008, as
8 amended by Section 6, Chapter 451, O.S.L. 2009 (62 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 41.5a-4), is
9 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 41.5a-4 A. The Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance
2 is authorized to:

3 1. Develop and publish a state policy and procedures for the destruction or disposal
4 of all electronic storage media to ensure that all confidential information stored on such
5 electronic media devices is destroyed or disposed of in a secure and safe manner;

6 2. Define the requirements for the secure destruction or disposal of electronic
7 storage media; and

8 3. Assist the Department of Central Services in implementing the policy and
9 procedures for the destruction or disposal of state electronic storage media.

10 B. The Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance shall notify all
11 agencies, boards, commissions and authorities of the policy and procedures for the secure
12 and safe destruction or disposal of electronic storage media.

13 C. The Department of Central Services shall remove all data from electronic
14 storage media from all surplus information technology and telecommunication
15 equipment before it is sold, donated, stored or destroyed. A state agency may remove
16 electronic storage media from their surplus information technology and
17 telecommunication equipment prior to sending the surplus to the Department of Central
18 Services, so long as the agency has the technical expertise for removal and that the
19 electronic storage media is sent for destruction or disposal pursuant to this subsection.

20 D. The Department of Central Services shall use existing and future funds from the
21 sale of state surplus equipment and appropriations, as necessary, to pay for the

1 destruction of electronic storage media of equipment processed through the Department
2 of Central Services.

3 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

4 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
5 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
6 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
