House Bill No. 2355

HOUSE BILL NO. 2355 - By: MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House and JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate.

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; making appropriations; authorizing expenditures of certain funds; stating purpose; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for  
2 Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
3 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of  
4 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
5 allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the  
6 provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general  
7 operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or  
8 repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

9 SECTION 2. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are hereby  
10 authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of  
11 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) from the Higher Education Capital Revolving Fund of  
12 the State Treasury for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education

1 pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the  
2 education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs,  
3 construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for  
4 Higher Education.

5 SECTION 3. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are hereby  
6 authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of  
7 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) from the Oklahoma Tuition Scholarship Revolving  
8 Fund of the State Treasury for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher  
9 Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for  
10 the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs,  
11 construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for  
12 Higher Education.

13 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for  
14 Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash  
15 Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary for the education and general operating budgets of the  
17 institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by  
18 the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

19 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made  
20 for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011  
21 (hereafter FY-11) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter  
22 FY-12). Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2011, and

1 must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15,  
2 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
3 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
4 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse to the credit of the  
5 proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted  
6 in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay  
7 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after the agency to which the  
8 funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
9 revision removing these funds from the FY-11 budget work program and after such  
10 revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

11 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

12 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
13 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
14 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
