House Bill No. 2360

HOUSE BILL NO. 2360 - By: MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House and JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate.

An Act relating to transportation; amending 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1101, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 264, O.S.L. 2007 (69 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1101), which relates to highway contracts; defining term; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1101, as amended by
2 Section 1, Chapter 264, O.S.L. 2007 (69 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1101), is amended to
3 read as follows:
4 Section 1101. A. All contracts for construction work upon the state highway system
5 shall be let and awarded pursuant to the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding
6 Act of 1974. If the project advertised pursuant to the provisions of the Public
7 Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 is for the construction of more than eight (8) miles of
8 road, and is not a surface treatment only project, said advertisement shall provide for
9 bids on sections of the road no longer than eight (8) miles, as well as bids on the project
10 as a whole. If the project advertised pursuant to the provisions of the Public Competitive
11 Bidding Act of 1974 is a surface treatment only project of more than twenty (20) miles of
12 road, the advertisement shall provide for bids on sections of the road no longer than

1 twenty (20) miles, as well as bids on the project as a whole. As used in this subsection,
2 “surface treatment only” means those projects that address the surface of the road,
3 highway, or bridge that do not add capacity or increase the structural integrity of the
4 facility.

5 B. The Department may extend a contract no more than twenty-five percent (25%)
6 of the length and extent of the original project. The price for the extension work shall not
7 be greater than the contract unit basis.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
11 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
