House Bill No. 2370

HOUSE BILL NO. 2370 - By: MILLER AND MARTIN (SCOTT) of the House and JOHNSON (MIKE) AND MYERS of the Senate.

An Act relating to state government personnel; amending Section 1, Chapter 17, O.S.L. 2002, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 300, O.S.L. 2008 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 3601.1), which relates to full-time-equivalent state employees; clarifying fiscal year; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 17, O.S.L. 2002, as last
2 amended by Section 5, Chapter 300, O.S.L. 2008 (74 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 3601.1), is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Section 3601.1 A. For purposes of Sections 3601.1 through 3603 of this title, the
5 term "employee" means a full-time employee or any number of part-time employees
6 whose combined weekly hours of employment equal those of a full-time employee, but
7 shall not include temporary employees working on a seasonal basis between May 1 and
8 October 31.

9 B. Beginning July 1, ~~2008~~ 2010, the maximum number of full-time-equivalent
10 employees for each of the following agencies, boards, commissions, departments, or
11 programs shall not exceed the numbers specified in this section, except as may be
12 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of this title.

4 C. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law,
5 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Public Employees
6 Retirement System Board of Trustees by law shall be set by the Board of Trustees.

7 D. Temporary employees of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts
8 Commission between the dates of November 1 and January 31 annually shall not be
9 counted toward the maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees provided for in
10 this section.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
13 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
14 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
