COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2552 - By: MCCULLOUGH AND RITZE of the House and ANDERSON of the Senate.

An Act relating to firearms; amending 19 O.S. 2001, Section 215.29, which relates to the carrying of firearms by district attorneys; authorizing assistant district attorneys to carry firearms under certain circumstances; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 215.29, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 Section 215.29 A. A district attorney may carry a firearm on his or her person
4 anywhere in the state to use only for personal protection if ~~he~~ the person has successfully
5 completed an approved course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms
6 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms training as set forth by
7 the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

8 B. At the discretion of the district attorney, the district attorney may allow an
9 assistant district attorney to carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the state
10 to use only for personal protection if the person has successfully completed an approved
11 course of firearm training conducted by a state-certified firearms instructor which meets

1 the minimum requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on Law
2 Enforcement Education and Training.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
