COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2558 - By: COOKSEY of the House.

An Act relating to electric utilities; allowing certain electric utilities to install voltage regulation technologies; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 287 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 A. An electric utility which is providing electricity services in the state may install
5 voltage regulation technologies.

6 B. For purposes of this section, "voltage regulation technologies" shall mean any
7 device that is capable of:

- 8 1. Reducing energy consumption and line losses;
- 9 2. Improving grid access and efficiency;
- 10 3. Raising or lowering voltage dynamically; and
- 11 4. A ninety-nine percent (99%) or more efficiency across at least ninety percent
12 (90%) of the load curve.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
