House Bill No. 2698

HOUSE BILL NO. 2698 - By: MCDANIEL (RANDY) of the House.

An Act relating to state government; creating the Oklahoma Government Website Information Act; requiring public bodies to make certain information available on its website; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 3106.3 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,  
3 reads as follows:

4 This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Oklahoma Government Website  
5 Information Act”.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
7 Statutes as Section 3106.4 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,  
8 reads as follows:

9 On or before January 1, 2011, public bodies shall make available on their Internet  
10 website or on a general website if a public body uses a general website, the following:

11 1. Any administrative rules adopted pursuant to the Administrative Procedures  
12 Act, which the public body uses to operate;

1           2. Any proposed administrative rules submitted by the public body pursuant to the  
2 Administrative Procedures Act;

3           3. Any statutes effecting the public body and its operations; and

4           4. Any statutes the public may find useful in interacting with the public body.

5           B. For purposes of this section, "public body" is defined as provided by paragraph 1  
6 of Section 304 of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7           SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
