House Bill No. 2724

HOUSE BILL NO. 2724 - By: SHERRER of the House.

An Act relating to public health and safety; requiring the development of certain database; requiring database to be searchable on website and made available without charge; providing database contain certain death certificates; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 1-324.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in  
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The State Department of Health shall develop and maintain a database of  
5 certain death certificates. Such database shall be searchable on the Department's  
6 website and shall be available to the public without charge.

7 B. The database shall contain any death certificate that is greater than fifty (50)  
8 years in age. The Department shall be responsible for updating the database on a  
9 monthly basis.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
