COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2794 - By: KOUPLEN AND DORMAN of the House.

An Act relating to elections; requiring certain officials to resign prior to filing for office; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 5-106.1 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 Any elected official shall resign from office before filing a Declaration of Candidacy
5 for any other elected position.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and
10 after its passage and approval.
