House Bill No. 2882

HOUSE BILL NO. 2882 - By: LUTTRELL of the House and SWEEDEN of the Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the Tribal Elder Parrish Williams Memorial Highway; designating the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers; providing for codification; and providing effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 That portion of State Highway 177 from White Eagle Road extending south to
5 Eagles Nest Road shall be designated as "Tribal Elder Parrish Williams Memorial
6 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
7 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

8 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
9 Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
10 numbering, reads as follows:

11 That portion of U.S. Highway 77 from the junction of U.S. Highway 77 and South
12 Avenue in Ponca City extending south to the junction of U.S. Highway 77 and East
13 Harding Road shall be designated as "Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Highway". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on
2 the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
