COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2912 - By: MORGAN of the House.

An Act relating to oil and gas; making it unlawful to injure, deface, alter, destroy, or tamper with oil and gas safety equipment; providing an exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 320.2 of Title 52, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,  
3 reads as follows:

4 After the effective date of this act, it shall be unlawful for any person to  
5 intentionally or maliciously injure, deface, alter, destroy or tamper with any safety  
6 equipment that is not their own and is used in the drilling or production of an oil or gas  
7 well, unless consent is given by or the person is authorized by the owner or operator of  
8 the safety equipment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
