House Bill No. 2942

HOUSE BILL NO. 2942 - By: NELSON AND SULLIVAN of the House.

An Act relating to attorneys and the State Bar; stating legislative intent that certain attorneys be given continuing legal education credit; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the
2 Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma Bar Association amend its
4 Rules for Mandatory Continuing Legal Education to provide that any employee of either
5 house of the Legislature who is an attorney licensed to practice law in this state be given
6 continuing legal education credit if the attorney drafts legislation for either house of the
7 Legislature.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
