**House Concurrent
Resolution No. 1062**

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1062 - By: FAUGHT of the House.

A Concurrent Resolution supporting the establishment of an Oklahoma Music Trail; directing certain public entities to cooperate and coordinate the Oklahoma Music Trail; and directing distribution.

1 WHEREAS, the establishment of an Oklahoma Music Trail would be of great
2 benefit to tourism and economic development for or in the State of Oklahoma; and

3 WHEREAS, site locations on the Oklahoma Music Trail would be places of
4 significance with respect to the musical heritage of Oklahoma, including residences,
5 commercial buildings or other structures that highlight the lives, careers and musical
6 achievements of musicians born in the state or who spent a substantial or significant
7 part of their musical career in Oklahoma; and

8 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame and Museum would be the logical
9 entity to provide support for the Oklahoma Music Trail and select and coordinate a
10 coalition of music historians and scholars who could develop a list of the most notable
11 musical sites that memorialize an individual, place or event within the state for inclusion
12 along the Oklahoma Music Trail; and

1 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame and Museum in partnership with
2 the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the Oklahoma Historical Society,
3 the Oklahoma Film and Music Commission and the Department of Transportation could
4 also coordinate, plan, and provide administrative support for the Oklahoma Music Trail;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, a detailed “Oklahoma Music Trail” map, brochure and website could
7 promote the history, heritage, legends, and folklore that characterize the musical
8 heritage of Oklahoma and dedicated markers along the Trail would honor the various
9 musical sites selected for inclusion along the Trail.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
11 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA
12 LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

13 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature supports the establishment of an Oklahoma Music
14 Trail.

15 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature direct the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame and
16 Museum, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the Oklahoma Historical
17 Society, the Oklahoma Film and Music Commission and the Department of
18 Transportation to cooperate and coordinate activities in a partnership to establish,
19 maintain, and promote the Oklahoma Music Trail.

20 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame
21 and Museum, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the Oklahoma
