HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1001 - By: DANK AND THOMPSON of the House and REYNOLDS of the Senate.

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 8C of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; modifying provisions related to certain qualifying income; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

1 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or
2 rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to
3 Section 8C of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

4 Section 8C. A. Despite any provision to the contrary, beginning January 1, 2005
5 2011, the fair cash value, as determined by law, on each homestead of an individual head
6 of household ~~whose gross household income from all sources for the preceding calendar~~
7 ~~year did not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this section, and which~~
8 individual head of household is sixty-five (65) years of age or older, shall not exceed the
9 fair cash value placed upon the property during the first year in which the individual
10 head of household was sixty-five (65) years of age or older ~~and had gross household~~

1 ~~income from all sources which did not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of~~
2 ~~this section.~~ Subject to the limitations of this section, the fair cash value shall not exceed
3 such amount as long as the individual head of household who is sixty-five (65) years of
4 age or older owns and occupies the property ~~and as long as the gross household income~~
5 ~~from all sources does not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this section.~~ If
6 any improvements are made to the property, the fair cash value of the improvements
7 shall be assessed in accordance with law by the county assessor and added to the
8 assessed value of the property. Once the fair cash value of the improvements has been
9 added to the fair cash value of the property, the total fair cash value shall not exceed the
10 revised valuation of the property so long as the individual head of household who is sixty-
11 five (65) years of age or older owns and occupies the property ~~and so long as the gross~~
12 ~~household income from all sources does not exceed an amount as provided in subsection~~
13 ~~B of this section.~~ For any individual head of household who is sixty-five (65) years of age
14 or older prior to January 1, 1997, and has gross household income from all sources of
15 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or less in calendar year 1996, the fair cash
16 value of the real property shall be the fair cash value placed upon the property on
17 January 1, 1997. If the individual head of household ceases to own and occupy the
18 property ~~or if the gross household income from all sources exceeds an amount as provided~~
19 ~~in subsection B of this section,~~ the fair cash value of the property shall be determined as
20 if the provisions of Section 8 of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma or
21 any other provisions relating to a limitation on the fair cash value of locally assessed real

1 property had been in effect during the time the property was valued pursuant to the
2 provisions of this section.

3 ~~B. The income threshold for the gross household income from all sources for an
4 individual head of household under this section shall not exceed the amount determined
5 by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to be the
6 estimated median income for the preceding year for the county or metropolitan statistical
7 area which includes such county. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall provide such
8 information to each county assessor each year as soon as such information becomes
9 available.~~

10 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set
11 forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

14 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

15 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends Section 8C of Article
16 10. Persons aged 65 or older who own a homestead can qualify for a property tax
17 benefit. A homestead owned by such persons will not be subject to increases in
18 value for property tax purposes. This value is known as fair cash value. The law
19 limits the amount of income persons may have in order to qualify for this benefit.

20 This measure would allow any person age 65 or older regardless of income to have
21 this benefit. The homestead of these persons would not be subject to any further
22 increases in fair cash value. This change would become effective January 1, 2011.
