8 A Resolution congratulating Lanette Miller on being
9 selected to participate in a NASA research flight;
and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Lanette Miller is a native Oklahoman and a graduate of
13 the University of Oklahoma; and

14 WHEREAS, Miller currently serves as an elementary science
15 education specialist with the Judson Independent School District in
16 Texas; and

17 WHEREAS, she was one of four hand-selected participants in
18 NASA's microgravity research flight on the C-9 plane, also known as
19 the "vomit comet", on January 8-17, 2009; and

20 WHEREAS, the team's research consisted of four experiments
21 called "Challenger's Lost Lessons", which were in the areas of force
22 and motion, magnetism, chromatography, and hydroponics; and

23 WHEREAS, these areas are based on the experiments never
24 completed by the late Christa McAuliffe, the school teacher who died

1 along with six astronauts in the space shuttle Challenger disaster
2 of 1986; and

3 WHEREAS, not only did the research information provide useful
4 and necessary data to NASA, but Miller was able to implement data
5 collected from the experiments into the science curriculum of Judson
6 ISD schools.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
8 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

9 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives congratulates native
10 Oklahoman Lanette Miller on being selected as one of four
11 participants in NASA's microgravity research flight held January 8-
12 17, 2009.
