# House Resolution No. 1075

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1075 - By: SANDERS of the House.

A Resolution commending the Boys and Girls Clubs of Oklahoma; designating March 25, 2010, Boys and Girls Clubs Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol; and directing distribution.

1       WHEREAS, Boys and Girls Clubs provide programs and services with a goal to  
2 inspire all young people, especially those from disadvantaged backgrounds, to realize  
3 their full potential as productive, responsible, and caring citizens; and

4       WHEREAS, through strong, proven development programs, leaders in the Boys and  
5 Girls Clubs stress character and leadership development, education and career  
6 advancement, and health and life skills. They encourage an appreciation for the arts and  
7 provide programs in sports, fitness and recreation; and

8       WHEREAS, the programs promote a better self-image and improved educational,  
9 social, emotional, and cultural awareness while encouraging community involvement,  
10 strong moral values, and enhanced life management skills; and

11       WHEREAS, through the years, Boys and Girls Clubs have encouraged young people  
12 to aspire to the highest level of personal development and to become good citizens who  
13 are involved in their communities; and

1           WHEREAS, Boys and Girls Clubs have designated March 25, 2010, their annual  
2 “Day at the Capitol”.

3           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
4 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA  
5 LEGISLATURE:

6           THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives recognizes and commends the Boys  
7 and Girls Clubs of Oklahoma for their outstanding services and valuable contributions  
8 they provide to the young people of this state and their families.

9           THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives designates March 25, 2010, "Boys  
10 and Girls Clubs Day at the Oklahoma State Capitol".

11          THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma Alliance of Boys and  
12 Girls Clubs.
