House Resolution No. 1081

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1081 - By: JACKSON of the House.

A Resolution proclaiming Sunday, April 18, 2010, as Church Women United Day; recognizing the display of the Ribbons of Tangible Hope; and directing distribution.

1 WHEREAS, Church Women United, started in December, 1941, is an ecumenical
2 movement that brings a diverse group of women from the United States and Puerto Rico
3 together into one community of prayer, advocacy and service; and

4 WHEREAS, Church Women United in Oklahoma engages women representing
5 seventeen supporting denominations and participating Christian women; and

6 WHEREAS, on April 18, 2010, at 2:30 p.m. on the South Plaza of the State Capital,
7 Ribbons of Tangible Hope will be displayed to further the vision of celebration of the
8 beauty and importance of life; and

9 WHEREAS, on April 19, 2010, members of Church Women United will gather in
10 their home communities, again, to display the Ribbons of Tangible Hope in an effort to
11 expand the celebration of the beauty and importance of life, with a culture of peace.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
13 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA
14 LEGISLATURE:

1 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives proclaims Sunday, April 18, 2010,
2 as Church Women United Day and further recognizes the day and the display of the
3 Ribbons of Tangible Hope as a symbol of the joining of all humanity in protecting life on
4 Earth.

5 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Lynne Bussell, National Secretary
6 of Church Women United.
