HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1105 - By: MARTIN (STEVE) of the House.

A Resolution honoring the memory of S.M. “Monsieur” Moore; proclaiming September 19, 2010, as S.M. “Monsieur” Moore Day; and directing distribution.

1 WHEREAS, the late S.M. “Monsieur” Moore, from his birth in 1903 until his death
2 at the age of 91, was the personification of the western pioneer; and

3 WHEREAS, for over 40 years, S.M. “Monsieur” Moore bred cattle and horses on his
4 10,000-acre ranch near Dewey; and

5 WHEREAS, S.M. “Monsieur” Moore was a founding member of several
6 organizations and served as a director of the American Quarter Horse Association from
7 1964 to 1979, as well as serving as their eleventh president in 1961; and

8 WHEREAS, S.M. “Monsieur” Moore’s influence was important in the successful
9 establishment of the Dewey Bank and many civic organizations in Northeastern
10 Oklahoma; and

11 WHEREAS, S.M. “Monsieur” Moore was an unparalleled blend of horse breeder,
12 cattleman, western pioneer, banker, oil producer, civic leader and mentor to his family
13 and friends.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
2 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA
3 LEGISLATURE:

4 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives hereby honors the memory of S.M.
5 “Monsieur” Moore.

6 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives does hereby proclaim September 19,
7 2010, as S.M. “Monsieur” Moore Day.
