Senate Bill No. 1033

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1033 - By:
SPARKS of the Senate and ARMES of the House.

An Act relating to agriculture; prohibiting wrongful injury or removal of certain cervidae; providing penalty; specifying damages; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- 1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 6-511 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:
- 4 A. No person shall wrongfully injure any cervidae upon the premises of a farmed
5 cervidae facility or wrongfully remove any cervidae from the premises of a farmed
6 cervidae facility.
- 7 B. Any violation of the provision of subsection A of this section shall be deemed a
8 felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine not less than Five
9 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a period
10 not exceeding two (2) years, or both such fine and imprisonment. In addition, any person
11 violating the provisions of subsection A of this section shall be liable for damages of not

1 less than three times nor more than ten times such a sum as would compensate for the
2 actual detriment.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
5 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval
