COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1250 - By:
NICHOLS of the Senate and TERRILL AND RITZE of the House.

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; prohibiting certain activities in
relation to DNA of newborn child; providing for codification; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1175 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 A laboratory, medical facility, hospital or birthing place is prohibited from the
5 unauthorized storage, transferring, use or databasing of DNA from any newborn child
6 without express parental consent.

7 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
9 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
