Senate Bill No. 1713

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1713 - By: GUMM of the Senate and BUCK of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain memorial highways; requiring permanent markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 1698.60 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in  
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of United States Highway 70 from the Bryan/Marshall county line  
5 extending west to the intersection of United States Highway 377 within the City of  
6 Madill limits shall be designated as the “Corporal Michael Eyre Thompson Memorial  
7 Highway”. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
8 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
10 Statutes as Section 1698.61 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in  
11 numbering, reads as follows:

12 The portion of United States Highway 377 from the City of Madill limits south to  
13 the Oklahoma state line shall be designated as the “Sergeant Clint E. Williams Memorial

1 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
2 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
4 Statutes as Section 1698.62 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in  
5 numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of United States Highway 70 from the Bryan/Marshall county line east  
7 to the City of Durant limits shall be designated as the "Chief Warrant Officer Brady  
8 Rudolf Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
9 permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
11 Statutes as Section 1698.63 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in  
12 numbering, reads as follows:

13 The portion of Scenic 77/County Line Road in Carter County from the junction of  
14 Scenic 77/County Line Road and State Highway 77 extending east to the junction of  
15 Scenic 77/County Line Road and State Highway 77S shall be designated as the "Three  
16 Hero Highway: Honoring and In Memory of District Attorney Mitchell D. Sperry, Sherriff  
17 Harvey Burkhart and Representative Terry Hyman". The Department of Transportation  
18 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
