COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1936 - By: CORN
of the Senate and PRUETT AND PETERS of the House.

An Act relating to children; permitting the Office of Juvenile Affairs to sell certain real estate; directing the deposit of certain monies; providing for the utilization of certain monies; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 2-7-612 of Title 10A, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. The Office of Juvenile Affairs may sell real estate owned by the State of
5 Oklahoma or the Office of Juvenile Affairs that is surplus to its use under the
6 jurisdiction of the Office of Juvenile Affairs located within LeFlore County and situated
7 within Talihina.

8 B. All monies received from the sale of the property, except those monies necessary
9 to pay the expenses incurred pursuant to the sale, shall be deposited in the Office of
10 Juvenile Affairs Revolving Fund 200 ("200 Fund"). Revenue derived from such real

1 estate sale deposited to the fund shall be utilized for the benefit of the Office of Juvenile
2 Affairs as necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Juvenile Affairs by
3 law. Such real estate sale shall not be subject to the provisions of Section 456.7 of Title
4 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
8 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
