COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1963 - By:  
LEFTWICH of the Senate and MURPHEY of the House.

An Act relating to public finance; amending Section 1, Chapter 340, O.S.L. 2008, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 451, O.S.L. 2009 (62 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 41.5a-4), which relates to the Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance; clarifying type of electronic storage for removal; specifying type of electronic storage media eligible for certain funds; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- 1       SECTION 1.   AMENDATORY    Section 1, Chapter 340, O.S.L. 2008, as  
2   amended by Section 6, Chapter 451, O.S.L. 2009 (62 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 41.5a-4), is  
3   amended to read as follows:
- 4       Section 41.5a-4 A. The Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance  
5   is authorized to:
- 6       1. Develop and publish a state policy and procedures for the destruction or disposal  
7   of all electronic storage media to ensure that all confidential information stored on such  
8   electronic media devices is destroyed or disposed of in a secure and safe manner;
- 9       2. Define the requirements for the secure destruction or disposal of electronic  
10   storage media; and

1           3. Assist the Department of Central Services in implementing the policy and  
2 procedures for the destruction or disposal of state electronic storage media.

3           B. The Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance shall notify all  
4 agencies, boards, commissions and authorities of the policy and procedures for the secure  
5 and safe destruction or disposal of electronic storage media.

6           C. The Department of Central Services shall remove all data from electronic  
7 storage media from all surplus information technology and telecommunication  
8 equipment before it is sold, donated, stored or destroyed. A state agency may remove  
9 electronic storage media from their surplus information technology and  
10 telecommunication equipment prior to sending the surplus to the Department of Central  
11 Services, so long as the agency has the technical expertise for removal and that the  
12 electronic storage media is sent for destruction or disposal pursuant to this subsection.

13           D. The Department of Central Services shall use existing and future funds from the  
14 sale of state surplus equipment and appropriations, as necessary, to pay for the  
15 destruction of electronic storage media of equipment processed through the Department  
16 of Central Services.

17           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
18 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
19 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
