COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 293 - By:
BURRAGE of the Senate and SCHWARTZ of the House.

An Act relating to cities and towns; stating legislative findings; providing for the expenditure of funds by certain entities for certain customers for energy conservation activities; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 35-206 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 The Oklahoma State Legislature hereby determines that expenditures of funds for
5 the purposes of the conservation of electricity or natural gas by public agencies is in the
6 public interest. In furtherance of this public interest, municipally owned utilities or
7 public trusts thereof or the Grand River Dam Authority may expend, with governing
8 board approval, funds to assist consumers in the establishment of energy conservation
9 activities if there is a defined and measurable conservation of energy. The expenditures

1 may be made subsequent to achievement of measures outlined in an energy audit or an
2 engineering audit of the consumer's operations.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
