Senate Bill No. 585

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 585 - By: FORD of the Senate and COODY of the House.

An Act relating to open records; amending Section 2, Chapter 175, O.S.L. 2003, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 399, O.S.L. 2005 (51 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 24A.28), which relates to confidential information exceptions; updating statutory outline; allowing certain public educational institutions to keep campus security plans confidential; allowing the discretionary release of information for certain purposes; providing for the release of certain higher education campus statistics and policies as required by certain law; defining certain term; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 175, O.S.L. 2003, as amended
2 by Section 1, Chapter 399, O.S.L. 2005 (51 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 24A.28), is amended
3 to read as follows:

4 Section 24A.28 A. The following information may be kept confidential:

5 ~~A~~. 1. Investigative evidence of a plan or scheme to commit an act of terrorism;

6 ~~B~~. 2. Assessments of the vulnerability of government facilities or public

7 improvements to an act of terrorism and work papers directly related to preparing the

8 assessment of vulnerability;

1 D. 1. Public educational institutions may keep confidential campus security plans.
2 An institution or agency may in its discretion release information contained in or related
3 to the campus security plan in order to design or implement the plan.

4 2. Nothing in this subsection shall preclude an institution or agency within The
5 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education from collecting and releasing information
6 relating to campus crime statistics and campus security policies as is required pursuant
7 to the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics
8 Act, 20 U.S.C. 1092(f).

9 3. For purposes of this subsection, “campus security plan” shall include, but is not
10 limited to, prevention and response procedures to and notification procedures for
11 perceived or actual security threats and incidents on or impacting the campus.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
14 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
15 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
