COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2730 - By: ROUSSELOT of the House and GARRISON of the Senate.

An Act relating to public safety; requiring branding of certain vehicle titles; directing law enforcement to notify Oklahoma Tax Commission; providing terms to appear on title; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 2-503A of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 Any law enforcement agency in this state that seizes a vehicle in which a controlled
5 dangerous substance has been manufactured that is forfeited pursuant to Section 2-503
6 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes may request that the Oklahoma Tax Commission
7 brand the certificate of title with the notation "Drug Manufacture Vehicle".

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
