House Bill No. 3343

HOUSE BILL NO. 3343 - By: CHRISTIAN of the House.

An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1750.6, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 360, O.S.L. 2007 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1750.6), which relates to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act; increasing fee amount for original, renewal and duplicate licenses; increasing time period for which licenses are valid; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1750.6, as last amended by
2 Section 4, Chapter 360, O.S.L. 2007 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 1750.6), is amended to
3 read as follows:
4 Section 1750.6 A. 1. Application for a license shall be made on forms provided by
5 the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training and shall be submitted in
6 writing by the applicant under oath. The application shall require the applicant to
7 furnish information reasonably required by the Council to implement the provisions of
8 the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act, including classifiable
9 fingerprints to enable the search of criminal indices for evidence of a prior criminal
10 record, including, but not limited to, a national criminal history record check as defined
11 by Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 payment. The individual license fee paid by a licensed agency will be
2 refunded to the agency.

3 b. In addition to the fees provided in this subsection, the original
4 application of an unarmed private investigator, unarmed security
5 guard or armed security guard shall be accompanied by a
6 nonrefundable fee for a national criminal history record with
7 fingerprint analysis, as provided in Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the
8 Oklahoma Statutes.

9 2. A licensee whose license has been suspended may apply for reinstatement of
10 license after the term of the suspension has passed. Any application for reinstatement
11 following a suspension of licensure shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable fee of
12 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for the reinstatement of a private investigator or unarmed
13 security guard, Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the reinstatement of an armed security guard,
14 and Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for reinstatement of a security or investigative
15 agency.

16 3. A licensee who fails to file a renewal application on or before the expiration of a
17 license shall pay a late fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for an individual license and a
18 late fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for an agency license.

19 4. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the fees, penalties, and fines
20 shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund. The prevailing fingerprint processing
21 fee for the original application for a private investigator, an unarmed security guard, or
22 an armed security guard shall be deposited in the OSBI Revolving Fund.

1 C. A Beginning November 1, 2010, a Security Guard License, Armed Security
2 Guard License, or Private Investigator License shall be valid for a period of two (2) three
3 (3) years and may be renewed for additional two-year three-year terms. A Security
4 Agency License or Investigative Agency License shall be valid for a period of five (5)
5 years and may be renewed for additional five-year terms. A special event license shall be
6 valid only for the duration of the event for which it is expressly issued. Any individual
7 may be issued up to two special event licenses during any calendar year.

8 D. The Council shall devise a system for issuance of licenses for the purpose of
9 evenly distributing the expiration dates of the licenses.

10 E. Pursuant to its rules, the Council may issue a duplicate license to a person
11 licensed pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private
12 Investigator Act. The Beginning November 1, 2010, the Council may assess a fee of Four
13 Dollars (\$4.00) Eight Dollars (\$8.00) for the issuance of a duplicate license. The fee must
14 accompany the request for a duplicate license.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
