HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1066 - By: MORRISSETTE of the House.

A Resolution seeking a freeze on out-of-state travel reimbursements; providing for exceptions.

1 WHEREAS, there is projected to be a large budget shortfall this year for fiscal year
2 2010, which may result in a special session of the Legislature; and

3 WHEREAS, Oklahoma is enduring an increasingly dire economic climate, the
4 length and severity of which is as yet unknown; and

5 WHEREAS, economic uncertainty provides a number of challenges for the budget
6 year, and thus calls for thrift and sacrifice in all areas of government; and

7 WHEREAS, all agencies are looking at ways to cut their budgets; and

8 WHEREAS, furloughs are a real possibility for state agencies in the near future.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
10 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA
11 LEGISLATURE:

12 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives seeks a freeze on all out-of-state
13 travel reimbursements, unless deemed official state business, and to the exclusion of
14 public safety agencies.
