ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1152 - By: BARRINGTON of the Senate and
TERRILL of the House.

(Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation - authorizing sale of property –
noncodification - effective date –
emergency)

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the
2 Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

3 A. On or after September 1, 2009, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is
4 authorized to sell the following described property in Oklahoma County in whole or in
5 part:

6 Legal Description of property to be sold.

7 A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 24, Township 12 North, Range 3 West of the
8 Indian Meridian, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, described as:

9 COMMENCING at the northwest corner of said NW/4;

10 Thence N89°30'53"E on the north line of said NW/4 (the bearing upon which this
11 description is based) a distance of 618.00 feet to the Point of Beginning;

1 Thence continuing N89°30'53"E on North line of said NW/4 a distance of 252.00
2 feet;
3 Thence S00°13'08"E parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a distance of 280.00
4 feet;
5 Thence S89°30'53"W parallel with the North line of said NW/4 a distance of 360.00
6 feet;
7 Thence N00°13'08"W parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a distance of 161.65
8 feet;
9 Thence N89°30'53"E parallel with the North line of said NW/4 a distance of 108.00
10 feet;
11 Thence N00°13'08"W parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a distance of 118.35
12 feet to the Point of Beginning;
13 The above description has a gross area of 2.02 acres more or less subject to
14 easements and rights-of-way of record.
15 Such sale shall be contingent upon submission of the sale of this property for public
16 auction or sealed bids by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation in compliance with
17 Section 129.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
18 B. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is directed to transfer any monies
19 received from the sale of the property described in subsection A of this section to the
20 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the OSBI Revolving Fund established by
21 Section 150.19a of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
2 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
3 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
