13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Human  
15 Rights Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so  
18 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon  
19 the Oklahoma Human Rights Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
21 Oklahoma Human Rights Commission shall budget all funds in the  
22 following categories and amounts:

5 for each budget category.

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
8 upon the Oklahoma Human Rights Commission by law shall be set by the  
9 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
10 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
11 ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Human Rights Commission for the  
12 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
13 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
14 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
15 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
16 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
