ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1365 - By: COFFEE AND GUMM of the Senate and
RUSS of the House.

[wildlife - authorizing persons under a certain age to purchase certain licenses
during a certain period of time -
effective date]

~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, as last amended by
2 Section 16, Chapter 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-114), is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 Section 4-114. A. All legal residents who have resided in the state for at least six
5 (6) months may purchase lifetime fishing licenses, lifetime hunting licenses or lifetime
6 combination hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation Director.

7 B. 1. The fee for these licenses shall be:

8 ~~1. Lifetime~~

9 a. lifetime fishing license, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00);₂

10 ~~2. Lifetime~~

11 b. lifetime hunting license, Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00);₂

12 ~~3. Lifetime~~

1 c. lifetime combination hunting/fishing license, Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars
2 (\$750.00);₂

3 ~~4. Lifetime~~

4 d. lifetime hunting license for persons sixty (60) years of age or older, Two
5 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00);₂

6 ~~5. Lifetime~~

7 e. lifetime fishing license for persons sixty (60) years of age or older,
8 Thirty Dollars (\$30.00);₂ and

9 ~~6. Lifetime~~

10 f. lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for persons sixty (60)
11 years of age or older, Two Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$215.00).

12 2. The fee for a resident lifetime fishing license, a lifetime hunting license, or a
13 lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for a legal resident of Oklahoma under
14 eighteen (18) years of age may be paid for by installments not to exceed a three-year
15 period of time and in a manner determined by the Director. The lifetime license will only
16 be issued and become valid upon full payment. If the entire license fee is not received
17 three (3) years from the date the application is received, any funds received shall be
18 forfeited and will not be refunded.

19 C. Legal resident having proper certification from the United States Department of
20 Veterans Affairs or its successor certifying that the person is a disabled veteran may
21 purchase a disability lifetime combination hunting/fishing license from the State Wildlife
22 Conservation Director. The fees for the license shall be as follows:

1 1. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for veterans having a disability of less than sixty
2 percent (60%); and

3 2. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for veterans having a disability of sixty percent
4 (60%) or more.

5 D. The use of the licenses provided in this section are subject to those restrictions
6 provided by statute and the regulations of the Wildlife Conservation Commission.

7 Except as otherwise provided for in this section, the lifetime hunting license shall be in
8 lieu of all annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

9 E. Nonresidents may purchase a lifetime nonresident fishing license. The fee for
10 such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

11 F. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a duplicate will be issued by the
12 Department of Wildlife Conservation for a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

13 G. A lifetime licensee shall not lose the privileges of such license by a subsequent
14 transfer of residency.

15 H. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsections B, C and E of this
16 section, a person purchasing a lifetime fishing, hunting or combination license shall be
17 required to purchase a Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. ~~Each person shall have~~
18 ~~the stamp in their possession while hunting, fishing, or taking any wildlife.~~ The fee for
19 the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) which
20 will be added to the respective lifetime license fee. The fee for the stamp shall be
21 distributed as follows:

- 1 a. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) from each stamp shall be deposited in the
2 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created in Section 4-141 of this title, to
3 be used to retire the obligations and related expenses as authorized
4 pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes or to
5 purchase, lease, or purchase easements on real property to be used as
6 public hunting, fishing, and trapping areas; and
- 7 b. Five Dollars (\$5.00) from each stamp shall be deposited in the
8 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created in Section 4-141 of this title, to
9 be used by the Commission for management of the real property
10 acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes or acquired with proceeds from the Oklahoma Wildlife Land
12 Stamp fee.

13 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall prescribe, by rule, the
14 form, design, and manner of issuance of the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

15 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or defeasance of the
16 obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
17 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp and Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp
18 fee requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2011.
