5 upon the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission by law shall be set by
6 the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the
7 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall not exceed

8 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Merit Protection
10 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be
11 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
12 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
13 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
14 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
