13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of  
15 Disability Concerns from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
19 imposed upon the Office of Disability Concerns by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Office  
21 of Disability Concerns shall budget all funds in the following  
22 categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
7 upon the Office of Disability Concerns by law shall be set by the  
8 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
9 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June  
10 30, 2011. The Office of Disability Concerns for the fiscal year  
11 ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
12 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
13 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
14 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
15 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
