12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
14 Department of Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise  
15 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
17 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
18 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs  
19 by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
21 Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall budget all funds in  
22 the following categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law shall be set  
10 by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
11 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June  
12 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the  
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following  
14 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as  
15 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
16 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
