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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
16 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from any monies not
17 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
18 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of
19 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
20 to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of
21 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
23 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall budget
24 all funds in the following categories and amounts:

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry by
18 law shall be set by the State Board of Agriculture. The salary of
19 the Commissioner shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
20 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
21 The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, for the
22 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
23 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
24 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special

1 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
2 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
