11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
13 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
14 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
15 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
16 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

18 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
19 Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following categories
20 and amounts:

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the
11 Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal
12 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
13 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as
14 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
15 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
