12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
14 Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
16 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
17 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
18 upon the Department of Corrections by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
20 Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following  
21 categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
10 upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the  
11 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
12 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 2011. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal  
14 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be authorized to employ up to six  
15 percent (6%) of its total authorized full-time-equivalent employees  
16 in the unclassified service and shall be subject to the following  
17 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
18 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
19 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
20 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
