10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. The Supreme Court is hereby authorized to expend
12 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, from the State Judicial
13 Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____
14 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the
15 financial support of the district courts.

16 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
17 Supreme Court shall budget all funds appropriated or otherwise made
18 available for the operation of the district courts in the following
19 categories and amounts:

22 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the annual
23 compensation of the following employees of the district courts

 3 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
