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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Pardon and
14 Parole Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
17 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the Pardon and Parole Board by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Pardon
20 and Parole Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
21 and amounts:

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1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Office of the Pardon and Parole Board by law shall be set
6 by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director
7 shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable
8 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Office of the
9 Pardon and Parole Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011,
10 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
11 time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures
12 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
13 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
14 Oklahoma Statutes:
