13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
16 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
21 Oklahoma Historical Society shall budget all funds in the following
22 categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the
11 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society. The salary
12 of the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall
13 not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum and the salary of the
14 Deputy Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall
15 not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Historical
17 Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject
18 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
19 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
20 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
21 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
