13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
15 Oklahoma Historical Society shall budget all funds in the following
16 categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law shall be set by the
6 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society. The salary
7 of the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall
8 not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum and the salary of the
9 Deputy Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical Society shall
10 not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Historical
12 Society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject
13 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
14 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
15 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
16 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
