Senate Bill No. 1684

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1684 - By: ALDRIDGE of the Senate and BANZ of the House.

An Act relating to counties and county officers; authorizing circuit engineering districts to establish County Energy District Authorities; stating procedures; providing for appointment of trustees and officers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- 1           SECTION 1.   NEW LAW   A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes as Section 460.2a of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,  
3 reads as follows:
- 4           A. The board of directors of a circuit engineering district, established pursuant to  
5 Section 687.1 et seq. of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, may by resolution, establish a  
6 County Energy District Authority pursuant to the provisions of this act, for the district.  
7 The authority shall be a public trust as provided for in Sections 176 through 180.3 of  
8 Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 9           B. The authority shall consist of five (5) trustees as follows:
- 10          1. Three members of the board of directors of the circuit engineering district; and

1           2. Two persons appointed by the board of directors of the circuit engineering  
2 district. The appointed members shall be residents of the district and shall not be  
3 elected officials.

4           C. The chair of the board of directors of the circuit engineering district shall serve  
5 as chair of the authority.

6           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof  
8 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
