11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
13 Department of Mines shall budget all funds in the following
14 categories and amounts:

3 Director of the Department of Mines shall not exceed _____
4 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
5 ending June 30, 2010. The Department of Mines for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
7 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
8 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
9 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
10 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
