[ State Capitol - management and control of space in State Capitol Building -  
providing provisions –  
effective date ]

~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

- 1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2001, Section 15.1, as last amended by  
2 Section 1, Chapter 317, O.S.L. 2009 (73 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 15.1), is amended to  
3 read as follows:  
4 Section 15.1 A. The Legislature shall have management and control of the  
5 following space in the State Capitol Building:  
6 1. The space on the third, fourth, fifth and sixth floors;  
7 2. The space in the basement that is occupied by the Legislature on June 1, 1995;  
8 3. Approximately six thousand nine hundred thirty-nine (6,939) square feet of  
9 space in the west wing of the first floor that is occupied by the Department of Libraries  
10 on June 1, 1995;

1 4. Approximately six thousand six hundred ninety-one (6,691) square feet of space  
2 in the west wing of the basement that is occupied by the Department of Libraries and the  
3 Department of Central Services on June 1, 1995;

4 5. Approximately three thousand seven hundred seventy (3,770) square feet of  
5 space in the west wing of the basement that is occupied by the Department of Central  
6 Services on June 1, 1995;

7 6. Approximately two thousand one hundred (2,100) square feet of space in the  
8 center of the basement that is occupied by the Department of Central Services and the  
9 Office of State Finance on June 1, 1995;

10 7. Approximately six hundred (600) square feet of space in the center of the  
11 basement that is occupied by the Department of Central Services on June 1, 1995;

12 8. Approximately two thousand three hundred one (2,301) square feet of space in  
13 the center of the basement that is occupied by the Department of Central Services on  
14 June 1, 1995;

15 9. Approximately twelve thousand five hundred sixty (12,560) square feet of space  
16 in the west wing of the first floor that is occupied by the Office of the Attorney General on  
17 June 1, 2001; provided, upon the Office of the Attorney General vacating such space, any  
18 renovations thereto shall be made in such a manner as to ensure preservation and  
19 maintenance of the cultural and historic integrity of the Capitol; and

20 10. Upon completion of the project authorized in Section 332 of this title, all space  
21 in the west wing of the second floor that is occupied by the Supreme Court, all space in  
22 the north wing of the second floor that is occupied by the Court of Criminal Appeals and

1 any other space in the State Capitol Building that is occupied by the appellate courts  
2 prior to relocation to the Wiley Post Historical Building; provided, the Supreme Court  
3 shall continue to have exclusive management and control of the Supreme Court  
4 courtroom and designated robing room located in the west wing of the second floor and  
5 the Court of Criminal Appeals shall continue to have access to the ~~courtrooms~~ courtroom  
6 and designated robing ~~rooms~~ room located in the ~~west and north wings~~ wing of the  
7 second floor upon such occasions as the ~~Chief Justice of the Supreme Court or the~~  
8 Presiding Judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals deems necessary and appropriate.

9 B. The authority of the Legislature to allot space may be delegated to the President  
10 Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Each  
11 House of the State Legislature shall have the exclusive charge of the purchase, use,  
12 allotment, and disposition of its respective chambers, committee rooms, fixtures,  
13 furniture, supplies, and apparatus, and shall be responsible for the use and preservation  
14 of same. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit the Legislature from allowing  
15 agencies of the executive or judicial departments to use space within the State Capitol  
16 Building that is under its management and control.

17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2001, Section 98.6, is amended to read as  
18 follows:

19 Section 98.6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the  
20 ~~Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission~~ Legislature  
21 shall have the management and control of the following space in the State Capitol  
22 Building:

1           The four offices and all space in the approximately one thousand (1,000) square feet  
2 of space on the first floor in the area designated as room 105, using January 1, 2001, as  
3 the reference point.

4           SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
