Senate Bill No. 1810

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1810 - By: NICHOLS of the Senate and THOMSEN of the House.

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety; authorizing certain law enforcement officers to obtain part-time law enforcement employment during certain furlough period; providing for reinstatement of certain restriction; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 2-105.4C of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:
4 Any Highway Patrol officer or other law enforcement officer employed as a full-
5 time-equivalent (FTE) of the Department of Public Safety and otherwise prohibited by
6 law or Department policy from obtaining part-time employment as a law enforcement
7 officer with any other law enforcement agency shall hereby be authorized to engage in
8 such part-time employment for the duration of any furlough period imposed by the
9 Commissioner of Public Safety or otherwise required by law. Any previous restriction on
10 such officers relating to outside employment shall be reinstated no longer than two

1 weeks following the end of any furlough status as determined by the Commissioner of
2 Public Safety.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
5 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
