11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Court  
13 of Criminal Appeals shall budget all funds in the following  
14 categories and amounts:

15 <u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
16 Court Operations	\$0.00	\$0.00

17 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
18 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
19 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law shall be set by the Judges  
20 of the Court of Criminal Appeals. The Court of Criminal Appeals,  
21 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the  
22 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
23 and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
24 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
