12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
14 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
17 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the District Attorneys Council by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
20 District Attorneys Council shall budget all funds in the following
21 categories and amounts:

9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the district attorneys and District Attorneys Council by law
14 shall be set by the district attorneys and the District Attorneys
15 Council as provided by Section 215.35C of Title 19 of the Oklahoma
16 Statutes. The district attorneys and District Attorneys Council for
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
18 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
19 and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
20 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
