12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
14 State Fire Marshal from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
15 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
17 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office
20 of the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following
21 categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law shall be set by the
9 State Fire Marshal. The salary of the State Fire Marshal shall not
10 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Office of the State Fire
12 Marshal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject
13 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
14 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
15 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
16 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
